EDITORIAL

Over the past weekend, Channel 13 reported that Channel 11 had purchased the video recording of a woman being assaulted and that C-11 refused to turn the tape over to the police unless they were subpoenaed. Nancy and I were outraged by this and she immediately sent C-11 an angry email. (C-11 responded with their rationalization for their actions. This will be made available at our next meeting or by email.) Is the reporting of the news truly in the public interest or in the self interest of the corporation and the channel's ratings? Be cautious, critical and questioning when you approach the media. I would also like to see laws passed requiring the news media to be required to immediately turn all documentation of a crime over to the police. I don't want to change the 1st Amendment but I do want some accountability from those in the media. They are very powerful and must be held accountable. I urge all of you, let the media know what you think. Remember, you can always boycott their sponsors. At the very least, demand the highest of reporting standards. Get involved and let them know what you think. Come to our meeting, read their responses and tell me what you think.
