### NEW STUDY

I received this email from a resident. It discusses the Inner Katy Transit Oriented Development Study-Scope of Work. Fellow residents, I obtained a copy of the Scope of Services from City of Houston Police Dept on this study. This study is going to be much more than a traffic/transportation study along the old MKT/SP rail line. "Community consensus on a practical and implementable transit-supportive development/redevelopment scenario for the study area is the ultimate project objective." It goes on... "The COH is undertaking the study to gauge the feasibility and most effective means (alignment, mode, etc.) of introducing high-capacity transit service to the Inner Katy area between downtown to just west of Loop 610. The city intends to use this opportunity to shape development and redevelopment possibilities and outcomes so as to maximize economic benefits, spur new investments in the area, and promote an enhanced central city setting for residential living and business and employment activity." Wilbur Smith is the consultant the COH selected to do the study which will kick off shortly. The study is to take 8 months. PD's webpage will have a section dedicated to this study that is to be updated regularly and will include info on meetings.

Tasks:

1. Outreach-Steering Committee, public meetings, key person interviews.
2. Existing Conditions Overview.
3. Baseline Analysis Overview.
4. Alternative Development Scenarios-2 plans, with 20 year time line for development
5. Feasibility Analysis
6. Preferred Scenario-strategy action plan to implement proposals.

We will try to keep you informed on the status of this study.
